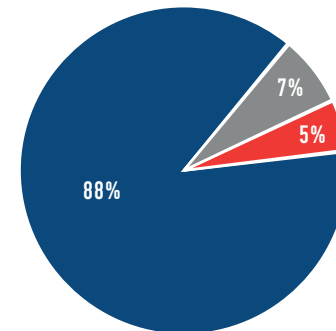

WAYS TO SUPPORT HG

- \$10,000 allows for "Adventure Club" opportunities for Idaho School for the Deaf and Blind students
- \$5,000 funds one Veteran for a week-long therapeutic program
- \$2,500 provides 5 full day 1:1 adaptive ski lessons, empowering participants to build skills, confidence, and independence on the mountain
- \$1,000 covers flights and a unit jacket for one Veteran, ensuring they arrive ready to connect, belong, and take on new adventures
- \$500 fuels our HG vehicles
- \$100 supports our scholarship fund, opening the door for more individuals to access recreation
